

The EV Show Horse committee met on September 10<sup>th</sup> and is pleased to submit the following summary of business.

<p><b>Winter Clinic/Protocol Day</b></p>	<p>After two successful protocol days this year, the Show Horse Committee have confirmed that they are currently reviewing potential dates for 2025 and are expecting to confirm dates and venues within the next few months.</p> <p>One clinic/protocol day will be hosted at WPNEC, with a regional venue to be sourced and organised by the Show Horse Young Ambassador, Charlotte.</p>
<p><b>Judge's Seminar (Webinar)</b></p>	<p>Details to follow shortly however, the Young Ambassador (Charlotte) will be assisting with the planning of this Seminar in collaboration with the EV office and Show Horse Committee.</p>
<p><b>December Show</b></p>	<p>The Committee has commenced their review of the December Show schedule and are expected to revisit this in early September, with a release date pending for October after Melbourne Royal.</p>
<p><b>EV Summer Show</b></p>	<p>Planning will commence for the event after an initial review of the schedule. Additional details will follow in October, with breeds societies and external organisations to be engaged before September.</p>
<p><b>EV Annual Awards &amp; Show Horse</b></p>	<p>The Committee will commence a review of the existing criteria and nomination forms for the 2025 EV Annual Awards.</p> <p>Additional details will be shared once the criteria have been reviewed, with information about eligible events to be available before the end of the year.</p>
<p><b>Young Ambassador</b></p>	<p>Charlotte Richardson has been confirmed as the new Show Horse Young Ambassador of the Year.</p> <p>Charlotte joined the Committee for their meeting and provided some insight into the development of a mentorship program that could be implemented to support young competitors, grassroots or developing competitors.</p>
