Chair

The role of the EVSJC Chair is to act as a liaison between the committee, riders, officials, event organisers, and EV. The Chair's responsibilities are diverse and require a deep understanding of show jumping in Victoria and Australia. The Chair is responsible for organising the monthly EVSJC meeting and collaborating with EV to produce agendas, minutes, and correspondence. The Chair also works closely with the EV CEO on Show Jumping matters. Furthermore, the Chair manages events and serves as the DJWTS.

Secretary/Treasurer

The Secretary/Treasurer will be responsible for checking of financial reports, budgets, collaborating with the accounts team to ensure compliance with financial policies and accurate reporting. Additionally, they may be required to assist with and coordinate some administrative tasks (excluding agenda, summaries, and minutes which is supported by the office discipline staff).

Riders Representative (Riders Rep)

We are currently searching for the best candidate to fill the role of Riders Rep. The ideal candidate should be a professional or semi-professional rider and possess a positive and proactive attitude to represent the riders effectively and resolve any issues that may arise. It is also important that the Riders Rep communicates any problems clearly and objectively to the EVSJC to achieve a successful outcome for all parties involved. Additionally, the Riders Rep may be asked to assist with organising clinics.

Officials Representative

The Officials Representative organises all the up skilling opportunities for aspiring and current officials. The EV SJC supports anyone interested in official training by heavily subsidising course attendance fees. As the Official Representative, you will closely collaborate with the EV office to arrange clinics, presenters, venues, catering, attendance lists, and fee reimbursements. You will also work with EA to ensure that all new officials, renewals, or up skilling of officials are approved by EV and communicated with EA. From 2024, the EVSJC will introduce new initiatives to encourage more people to become officials, and your contribution to this will be required.

Organising Committee Representative (OC Rep)

The OC Rep is an exciting new position on the EVSJC. This role will support and assist clubs with event planning, ensuring compliance with regulations, and facilitating communication between the state committee and event organizers. They will provide guidance on event planning, scheduling, and logistics while also supporting Jumping Victoria events, such as the Jumping State Titles.
